



Το Τμήμα Διοίκησης Τουρισμού του Πανεπιστημίου Πατρών συνδιοργανώνει και φιλοξενεί το ενδέκατο διεθνές συνέδριο για τον τουρισμό και τον ελεύθερο χρόνο, με τίτλο “Pathways to Resilience: sustainable practices in tourism and leisure”.

Θα γίνουν περί τις 90 επιστημονικές εισηγήσεις, από συνέδρους που προέρχονται από 23 χώρες. Εκ των ομιλιών, οι μισές θα γίνουν ζωντανά με φυσική παρουσία των συνέδρων, ενώ οι υπόλοιπες ασύγχρονα (βιντεοσκοπημένες). Περιλαμβάνονται τρεις συνεδρίες διακεκριμένων προσκεκλημένων ομιλητών (“plenary sessions” στο πρόγραμμα), καθώς και συζητήσεις στρογγυλής τραπέζης.

Η κύρια εστίαση του συνεδρίου είναι στη διερεύνηση μονοπατιών προς την ανθεκτικότητα και τις βιώσιμες πρακτικές στον τουρισμό και στον ελεύθερο χρόνο. Εντός αυτού του πλαισίου, θα γίνουν ομιλίες στις επιμέρους θεματικές των μεταβαλλόμενων διαστάσεων του φαινομένου του τουρισμού, των επιχειρηματικών κλάδων που σχετίζονται με τον τουρισμό, καθώς και με αναδυόμενα κρίσιμα ζητήματα που σχετίζονται με τη μελέτη του φαινομένου του τουρισμού.

Το συνέδριο, το οποίο θα διεξαχθεί στο Συνεδριακό και Πολιτιστικό Κέντρο του Πανεπιστημίου Πατρών στο Ρίο, ξεκινά τη Δευτέρα 15^η Ιουνίου στις 09:00 και η τελευταία ομιλία ξεκινά στις 4:35μ.μ. της Τρίτης 16^{ης} Ιουνίου.
